

Junction Educational Foundation Minutes – Friday, October 2, 2020

The Zoom meeting and was opened by Jessie at 3:30 pm. We discussed the minutes from the September meeting and after a motion by Hope and a second by Melisa, the motion to approve the minutes was approved. Kayla and Rachel shared information about the treasurer's report.

Melisa shared information about several items on the agenda because she had to leave the meeting early. The Junction staff was given information about the Read-a-Thon, which Melisa chairs, and discussed the arrangements at the staff meeting on September 30. Parents will collect data on the reading that is happening at home. \$1900 has been raised so far for the event.

Rachel shared about the work that is being done for the Fall Carnival to be held on Friday, October 30, during school.

Melisa asks for a Fall Grant of \$450 for the book club as she has over twice as many members as she anticipated and needs to purchase more books for the group. Jessie moved to grant the money to book club and Kelly seconded. The grant was approved by the Board. Susan shared about how the Garden Club had purchased a Tuff Shed for \$5100. They had met with the Foothill High School agriculture teacher who had agreed to help get the shed installed and set up for use.

The Fall Carnival committee will meet on Wednesday, October 7, at 2:35 at Junction for additional planning.

Hope reported on what was happening with the School Board and ended the discussion by asking the JEF members to support the Principal in his request for parents to wear masks when they come on campus to pick up their children.

Jessie moved that Susan Moreno be on the JEF Board. Kelly seconded, and Susan's appointment was approved by all members. Jessie gave an overview of the new job descriptions for each of the officers. After a motion by Kayla and a second from Hope, the Board approved the new job descriptions.

Kayla and Rachel shared some ideas about fundraising. North State Giving was discussed as a possible mode for the fund raising which would be to support the JEF business plan for next school year, 2021 – 2022. We will continue to research other ideas and continue the discussion at the next meeting.
